FAMILY DISCOUNT: Gather the family to receive our family discount for 3 or more members from the same household who join our club. You will receive a discount of \$10 per family member in the form of a refund after the registration period is complete.

REFUNDS - Refunds will not be given to any player who withdraws after team lists have been published (this excludes injury, pregnancy where an appropriate medical certificate is received, and the player has not yet taken the court).

Grading & Training

ALL MANC NETBALL TEAMS TRAIN ON A **WEDNESDAY NIGHT**. TIMES TO BE DETERMINED BY YOUR TEAMS COACH, PLEASE KEEP THIS IN MIND PRIOR TO REGISTERING.

Juniors and intermediates under 10's-14's

Mount Annan Netball Club will conduct practical grading sessions on all Junior players (under 10's, 11's, 12's and Intermediates). Teams will be formed, reliant upon both the practical grading session, together with additional information at hand (i.e. Coaches assessment from the previous year, where applicable). This ensures that players are playing at a level appropriate to their skill set, which should enable players to gain maximum enjoyment from their netball.

Junior Division and Seniors

Players may register as an individual. New players to the club and returning individual players will be required to attend a grading evening. The grading committee will evaluate the players ability to determine appropriate team level.

Returning players may choose to submit a team to the grading committee. It is a requirement that teams are formed based on similar player ability, have no less than 9 players and bring their own coach/manager. The coach/manager needs to email a list of players to our senior registrar and individuals should include the name of the team on their registration form. The registrar will forward a link for teams to use to register. Pre formed teams may be asked to attend grading to determine team grading level.

MANC'S grading committee works tirelessly behind the scenes and endeavours to release teams as quick as possible. Once teams are formed, the club submits its teams to Camden & District Netball Association for competition grading. The C&DNA grading committee considers previous playing history, player skill and ability and previous team statistics when determining competition grades for 2023.

NetSetGo (5-9's)

NetSetGO is Australia's official starter program for children aged 5 to 10. A chance to learn the netball basics, NetSetGO helps children gain confidence, get active and make friends, as well as learning fundamental life skills like teamwork along the way. There's no skill level required to participate and for a lot of children, this is the first time they'll pick up a netball or put on a bib. Each participant will receive their own starter pack which includes a netball and t-shirt, which can be personalised for a few extra dollars (sent directly from Netball NSW).

NetSetGo skills 5-7 year olds - this program is designed for those new to netball. Players are taught basic skills in a fun environment. Skills lessons take place on a Wednesday night.

NetSetGo competition 7-9 year olds - players will be placed in a team based on age and play modified netball games on a Saturday morning.

Please pay attention to the sizing chart as sizes may be different. Orders must be placed by Saturday 4 February to ensure that they arrive prior to the commencement of the season.
